ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.46 dated 28.03.2019, under Sections 379-B, 323 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that a tablet and mobile phone belonging to the complainant had been snatched by 4 persons. He further contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and only a stick was recovered from the petitioner while the recovery of mobile phone and tablet was effected from the co-accused. The petitioner is 26 years old and is not involved in any other case. He is in custody for over 3 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh, states that only a stick was recovered from the petitioner, investigation has been completed and charges have been framed but no witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when only a stick was recovered from the petitioner, he is not involved in any other case, the investigation has been completed and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
