Petitioners-Kuldeep Singh Mann and Jaswinder Singh Mann have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in a case FIR No.89 dated 04.10.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Sunam, District Sangrur, under Sections 306 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version,

CRM-M-27454-2019

deceased-Jasvir Singh invested his own money and the money of other persons i.e. about Rs.30 lakh with the Company of the present petitioners. The persons whose money had been invested, were harassing him. However, the petitioners did not return the money and Jasvir Singh committed suicide.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioners have been in custody since 24.11.2018. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of case may take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail; without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and in view of the custody period, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
