The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.180 dated 01.05.2019, registered under Sections 498-A, 323, 328, 342, 406, 420, 494 read with Section 201 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Thanesar, District Kurukshetra (Haryana).

Mr. Pradeep Virk, Advocate has put in appearance and filed his power of attorney on behalf of the complainant. Same is taken on record.

The petitioner is in custody since 06.06.2019. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and

keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long

time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Parv Sharma @ Gagan is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. Petitioner shall pay a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- by way of bank draft to the complainant-Kritika towards interim compensation. The aforesaid amount will be without prejudice to the rights of the parties and shall be subject to the final outcome of the trial.
2. Petitioner shall furnish bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate
3. Petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
4. In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality, the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
5. He shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.
