This is an application to place on record rejoinder to the reply filed by the respondents.

In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner, who is the mother of Constable Balwinder Singh and Swaran Singh is seeking the benefit in respect of service rendered by her sons.

In the reply, the respondents have stated that Constable Balwinder Singh having Belt No.38/Fzr joined duty on 18.11.1992 but was discharged under 12.21 of Punjab Police Rules on 08.06.1993.

Similarly, Sh. Swaran Singh Constable No.1317/Fzr joined duty on

18.05.1989 and he was dismissed from service on 08.06.1993. At the said period of time, Sh. Swaran Singh was working as Adhoc Head Constable. The copies of the orders, vide which both the sons of the petitioner were discharged/dismissed from service, have been attached as Annexures R-1 and R-2 with the reply. There is no challenge to the said orders.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to avail appropriate remedy in respect of the orders by which both the sons of the petitioner were discharged/dismissed from service.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
