Learned State counsel submits that the persons mentioned in para 4 are labourers and are not bonded labourers. Even otherwise, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the District Magistrate as per the provisions of Section 10 of Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that directions may be issued to the District Commissioner to take appropriate action as per the provisions of above Act.

Service of private respondents is dispensed with.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the appropriate authority under the Bonded Labour System (Abolition) Act, 1976 and seeks remedy as provided therein.
