The petitioners have filed the instant petition seeking a Mandamus for directing respondents no.2 and 3 to take steps for protection of their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondents no.4 and 5.

It has been averred in the petition that petitioners have got married with each other against the wishes of the elders and it is under such circumstances that they feel threatened.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, Police Station, Malaud informs the Court that the statements of the petitioners as well as of respondent no.4, who happens to be the father of petitioner no.1 have been recorded. As per such statements, there is no threat held out to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel representing respondents no.4 and 5 suffers a statement that the parents of petitioner no.1 are also not opposed to the matrimonial alliance of the petitioners.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition.

Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of as infructuous.
