Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.50 dated 04.05.2019 under Sections 419, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is already in custody for 2 months and 6 days. The investigations are complete, challan has been presented and the charges have been framed on 31.07.2019.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that there are serious allegations against the petitioner as the petitioner had impersonated Rambir Singh during recruitment for induction of the Indian Army. As per custody certificate, the petitioner is not involved in any other case. The case is triable by the Magistrate. The petitioner is alleged to be a young boy of 18 years.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
