The petitioners have filed the instant petition seeking a Mandamus for directing respondents no.2 and 3 to take steps for protection of their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondents no.4 to 6.

It had been averred in the petition that petitioners have got married with each other against the wishes of the elders and it is under such circumstances that they have no threats.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh, Police Station, City-2, Abohar informs the Court that the statements of the petitioners as well as of respondents no.4 and 5, who happen to be the parents of petitioner no.1 Neeru have been recorded. As per such statements, respondents no.4 and 5 are not opposed to the matrimonial alliance entered into between the parties. Further the petitioners themselves have stated that they do not apprehend any threat to their life and liberty.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition.

Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of as infructuous.
