The present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No. 71 dated 14.5.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC at Women Police Station, Chandigarh.

As per the allegations contained in the FIR, marriage between the petitioner and the complainant was solemnized on 15.8.2012 and out of the said wedlock a daughter was born on 6.10.2016. After the birth of the girl child, the complainant was not only neglected by her in-laws, but her husband started his affairs outside the matrimonial cord. He is having affairs with a widowed lady and after having prepared her passport, the petitioner had eloped with her. When the complainant tried to contact them, their mobiles were found switched off. The petitioner is alleged to have taken huge loan from the financial

institutions/Banks. The petitioner is alleged to have abandoned his wife and child and the financial institutions/Banks are harassing the complainant for recovery of the loan.

The alleged conduct of the petitioner in eloping with another lady and abandoning his wife and child, does not warrant grant of any relief to him. The allegations against the petitioner are very serious. The petitioner, by developing his love affairs outside matrimonial cord, cannot be allowed to go on ruining the lives of innocent women.

In view of the above, no case is made out for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
