Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.116 dated 04.06.2018 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short 'the Act') (Sections 25 and 29 of the Act added later on) at Police Station Mataur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner is not the owner of house No.412, Phase-7, Mohali whereas, petitioner owned a house in Sunny Enclave, Mohali and it was the co-accused, who was caught on the spot with the contraband and that too, the co-accused Ranjit Singh, has been granted bail on 12th December, 2019.

As far as petitioner is concerned, he is in custody since 22nd December, 2018.

Learned State counsel, on instructions of ASI Lakhwinder Singh, does not dispute the fact that Ranjit Singh has already been granted regular bail on 12th December, 2019. The trial would take time to conclude.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
