Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a criminal complaint No.89 dated 17.08.2018 titled as ***Jasbir Singh Versus Captain Singh and others*** under Sections 302, 120-B and 306 read with Section 34 IPC filed by respondent No.2-complainant before learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated July 01, 2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court and was admitted on bail. Now the case has been committed to the Court of Session and the complainant has been examined in the case.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant have not disputed the aforesaid fact. Power of attorney filed on behalf of respondent No.2 in Court today, is taken on record.
