HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.

On the last date of hearing, following order was passed:-

“On the last date of hearing, the Court was informed that unfortunately the petitioner died during the pendency of the present writ petition and time was taken to bring on record the legal heirs of the petitioner.

Despite the fact that nine months have passed, but no such application has been moved by the legal heirs for impleadment.

In the interest of justice, one last opportunity is granted to do the needful.

Adjourned to 02.05.2019.”

Counsel for the petitioner states that nobody has come forward for being impleaded as legal heirs, therefore, he is unable to move an application for bringing on record the legal heirs of the petitioner so that the proceeding in present petition could be continued.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, a liberty is granted that in case any legal heir is there, he/she can file application for restoration of the present writ petition.
