On 28.06.2019, while issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court:-

It is stated that petitioner No.1-Harwinder Kaur, aged about 21 years and petitioner No.2 Gurdit Singh aged about 24 years have got married against wishes of their family members, who are threatening to interfere in their marital life, as such to seek protection in that regard, they have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

Of course no body can be allowed to take law into his hands and to indulge in illegal activities.

Notice of motion for 12.07.2019.

In the meanwhile, respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali is directed to ensure that no physical harm is caused to the petitioners at the hands of private respondents or persons claiming under them. However, this order is

not to be taken as legalizing the alleged marriage between the petitioners and shall not save the petitioners from any criminal or civil action to which they may be found liable in view of the circumstances of the case.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, PS City Kharar, apprises the Court that the statements of petitioners as also private respondents No.4 and 5 who happens to be the parents of petitioner No.1 have been recorded.

As per statement recorded, the petitioners now do not apprehend any threat to their life and liberty. Respondents No.4 and 5 in their statement have deposed that they are not opposed to the matrimonial alliance entered into between the petitioners.

In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.
