In the present writ petition, the petitioner is seeking the deemed date of promotion as a Junior Engineer with effect from the date on which juniors to him were promoted and also re-fixation of his pensionary benefits thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has made representation dated 28.12.2015 (Annexure P-15) to the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide the representation by passing a speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents have no objection with regard to the grant of relief as being prayed by the counsel for the petitioner

for deciding his representation in a time bound manner.

Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 28.12.2015 (Annexure P-15) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
