The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.138 dated 16.05.2019, under Sections 147, 148, 323 and 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the incident is outcome of an altercation between the parties but no injury was caused to anyone. The medical examination of the injured was not conducted. He also states that the petitioners had also lodged a cross FIR against the complainant party.

This Court, by the order dated 01.07.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Yogdhyan, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation and not required for custodial interrogation, the order dated 01.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
