Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner on the premises that respondent No.3 i.e. Incharge, Economic Offences Wing, Sangrur is harassing him and repeatedly calling him to attend the office.

During the course of hearing, counsel would concede that the petitioner had attended the office of the Incharge, Economic Offences Wing, Sangrur on one solitary occasion and the second time over, he has chosen not to go there.

The averments made in the petition are completely deficient and do not inspire any confidence. From the pleadings on record, this Court cannot infer any threat perception that the petitioner is facing. Confronted with a situation where this Court would not incline to intervene, counsel seeks withdrawal of the petition.
