HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

Retired Municipal Employees Welfare Association has filed the present writ petition to make the payment of the medical allowance, medical reimbursement and LTC alongwith pension as being paid to the other Government employees.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a representation has been submitted by the petitioner in this regard.

A general statement has been made in the writ petition that the benefits for which the employees are entitled for, are not being released by the authorities. No specific averment has been made, according to which, the required benefit to the entitled employees. An employee, who is aggrieved, has to raise an objection in respect of non-grant of any benefit, for which the said employee is entitled for. The averments are vague and

the petition is being filed by the Employees Welfare Association, which is not permissible. In case, any employee has any grievance in respect of his or her entitlement, they can surely approach the appropriate forum for the grant of the relief.

The present writ petition is not at all maintainable in this form and is dismissed.
