ARUN PALLI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner, who is a practicing Advocate of this Court, purports to have filed this petition in public interest seeking the following reliefs:-

A) To complete the construction of PR-5 road from near Jamuna Apartment (west side of Kharar) to Sector-39, Chandigarh (via Hassanpur - Behlolpur) as shown in the Tricity Plan in yellow colour (Annexure P-10).

B) To complete the construction of the road from Kharar T-Junction to Sector 56, Phase-I, Mohali (at Dara Studio Chowk, Mohali) (via Jhungian - Sector 123, New Sunny Enclave - Raipur), as shown yellow colour in Tricity Plan (Annexure P-10).

C) To complete the construction of Airport Road from Gopal Sweets (Opp. VR Punjab Mall) to Hassanpur connecting with PR-5 road at Hassanpur as shown in yellow colour of Tricity Plan (Annexure P-10).

2. At the outset, upon being specifically asked if the petitioner, prior to the institution of this petition, had even once represented to the respondent-authorities as regards the

grievance and concerns being raised herein, he fairly concedes that he never approached the respondents in this regard. And faced with this, he rather submits that let this petition be permitted to be withdrawn, at this stage, to enable him to move the respondents in the first instance by filing a comprehensive representation. However, it is urged that a direction be issued to the respondent-authorities that if any such representation is made, the same shall be decided within a specified time.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty prayed for.
4. We are sanguine that if the petitioner moves any such representation, as indicated above, the same shall be duly considered and dealt with by the concerned authorities and appropriate steps in accordance with law shall be taken as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order, after affording an opportunity of hearing to all the stake-holders.
