1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.26, dated 4.12.2015, registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Ambala, under Sections 294, 452, 504, 506 IPC (Sections 354, 120-B, 34 IPC added later on), and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Madan Lal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala has been filed. The same is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 3.7.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

4. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ambala, has been received wherein it has been reported that statement of complainant Lovleen as well as of petitioners/accused Rajat Kumar, Mamta, Geeta and Sapna, have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ambala, opined that the the parties have got their statements recorded voluntarily, without any undue influence or coercion and the compromise effected between the parties is genuine.
5. In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.26, dated 4.12.2015, registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Ambala, under Sections 294, 452, 504, 506 IPC (Sections 354, 120-B, 34 IPC added later on), and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
