The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.47, dated 06.05.2018, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Phase-11, SAS Nagar(Mohali)

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had been granted interim bail by the trial Court and he was appearing before the trial Court regularly but as he was admitted in hospital, he could not appear before the trial Court on 06.06.2019 and consequently his bail bonds were cancelled. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner shall appear before the trial Court and on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent himself without prior permission of the Court. He further states that petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court and prefer an application for regular bail which may be ordered to be decided expeditiously in view of the afore-noted facts.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that in the event of the petitioner surrendering before it and preferring an application for regular bail, the same shall be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.
