ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 29 dated 10.04.2019 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the injury which is attributed to the petitioner is on the little finger of the right hand of the complainant. The petitioner is 23 years of age and not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 03.07.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kamal Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 03.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
