Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.64 dated 07.06.2019, registered at Police Station Rahon, District S.B.S.Nagar, under Sections 380 and 454 of the Indian Penal Code.

On 04.07.2019, this Court passed the following order:

“Notice of motion for 5th November, 2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

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Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 04.07.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Head Constable Haim Raj, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation; recovery has already been effected and he is not required for any further investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 04.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
