The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 16.1.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 14734 of 2006. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondent(s) first to consider the case of the petitioner for the grant of benefit under instructions dated 19.9.1995 for the service rendered by the husband of the petitioner from 24.11.1977 till 24.12.1981 for summer vacations. Thereafter, an appropriate order shall be passed by the respondent(s) in respect of the claim of the petitioner for the grant of pension. In case, it is found that after granting the benefit of summer vacation, the husband of the petitioner had worked continuously for one year in any year, the benefits under 1964 Rules needs to be

extended to the petitioner.”

Reply dated 17.9.2019 by way of affidavit of Sh. Raj Pal, District Elementary Education Officer, Mini Secretariat, Karnal annexing order dated 11.7.2019 was filed. The claim of the petitioner has been rejected.

The grievance of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the directions of this court were to consider the case of the petitioner under instructions dated 19.9.1995, but the said instructions have not been considered.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that a fresh order would be passed within six weeks from today after considering the instructions dated 19.9.1995.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

In case the needful is not done, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
