GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.9, dated 23.01.2014, registered at Police Station Phase-8, District SAS Nagar, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 03.7.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the Trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Mohali, has been received wherein it has been reported that statement of complainant Sonia as well as of petitioner/accused Vinod Kumar, have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant has specifically stated that the matter has been compromised with the petitioner and she does not want to pursue with the matter. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Mohali, specifically

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reported that the compromise has been effected between the parties voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion.

4. In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in **2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab**, the petition is allowed and FIR No.9, dated 23.01.2014, registered at Police Station Phase-8, District SAS Nagar, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
