Grievance of the petitioner is that she is not being considered for appointment as Anganwari Worker on the ground that she does not reside in the area qua which the appointment is being made. While rejecting her request for appointment, reliance has been placed on the government instructions which envisages that a candidate should be permanent resident of concerned ward and since the petitioner is not resident of Ward No.15, her candidature was not found fit by the office of respondent No.3.

2. Learned counsel has drawn my attention to copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-4) issued by Government of India as also copy of Passport of the petitioner (Annexure P-5) and contends that reasoning given by respondent No.3 while rejecting her candidature, is factually incorrect.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the candidature of the petitioner by verifying the Adhar Card and Passport of the petitioner, as contained at Annexures P-4 and P-5 respectively and pass -a speaking order, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

8. Disposed of in above terms.
