HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that respondent No.5 is not releasing his retiral benefits.

Counsel for the respondent No.5 raises a preliminary objection on the maintainability of the present writ petition against the Cooperative Society. Counsel submits that respondent No.5 is a Cooperative Society, which does not get any funds from the Government and there is no administrative control of the Government over it in any manner.

Counsel for the petitioner, keeping in view the objection raised on the maintainability of the writ petition before this Court against the Cooperative Society-respondent No.5, prays that he may

be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach competent authority under the Cooperative Societies Act, 1961 for redressal of the grievance of the petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
