GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case registered vide FIR No.152 dated 27.2.2019 under Section 20 of NDPS Act, Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.
2. The allegations in nut-shell are that the petitioner was found in possession of 750 grams of '*Charas*'.
3. The aforesaid quantity would fall within intermediate quantity i.e. less than the commercial quantity and in these circumstances, the fetters of Section 37 NDPS Act shall not be attracted.
4. The learned State counsel has pointed out that challan has already

been presented and the petitioner is not wanted in any other case.

5. Having regard to the abovesaid facts and circumstances and bearing in mind the fact that the petitioner is not wanted in any other case, in my opinion, no fruitful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. Accordingly, petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
