As per pleadings on record, petitioner no.1 is the wife of respondent no.6. It is submitted that on account of the harassment meted out to petitioner no.1 in the matrimonial home she was forced to run away. Further urged that even the father and brother of petitioner no.1 are not supporting her and accordingly she is currently staying with petitioner no.2.

A Writ of Mandamus is sought seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondents no.6 to 9.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without opining on the liaison between the petitioners herein, liberty is granted to them to approach respondent no.5 confined to the aspect of the threat that they are facing as regards life and liberty.

In the eventuality of any such application being made, respondent no.5 would be obligated to look into the matter and to take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
