ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

1. Petitioners herein seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner to the extent that they be regularised into the service and also their wages be given at par with the wages being given to the regularised employees.
2. Conceded position emerging out on perusal of the pleadings is that, the petitioners have been in uninterrupted service from 1995 onwards though, with certain break in the service, which too was restored by the order of this Court when they were reinstated with continuity of service .
3. In the premise, it is obvious that the nature of job on which they are employed is perennial in nature. Notwithstanding, they are neither being regularised nor are being paid as per the pay scale admissible to Class-IV employees.

4. In the premise, the writ petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondents to pay the petitioners equivalent to the minimum of pay scale, which is being paid to regular employees. It is expected of the respondents to pass appropriate orders with regard to regularisation of their services as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 6 months.

5. It is made clear that until the order as aforesaid are passed, *status quo qua* services of the petitioners shall be maintained.
