Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the official respondents to look into/decide the representations/complaints dated 06.05.2019 (Annexure P1) and 17.06.2019 (Annexure P-2).

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he will be satisfied if a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to dispose of the representations (Annexures P1 and P2).

It is the case of the petitioner that the petitioner is a widow lady and respondents No.4 to 6 have sold out her property. On raising demand for restoring the same to the petitioner, respondents No.4 to 6 are issuing threats to kill her.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that petitioner has moved representations (Ex.P1 and P2), however, despite giving complaints to respondents No.2 and 3, no action has been taken, so far. Counsel for the petitioner has relied upon the judgment “*Lalita Kumari vs Govt. of U.P.*

And others”, 2013(4) RCR (Criminal) 979, passed by the Hon'ble

Supreme Court and submits that though from the perusal of the complaint, a

cognizable offence is made out, yet, no action has been taken.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner in accordance with law after joining the parties and in the event of rejection of the representation, the copy of the same be supplied to Raj Kaur-petitioner.

Needful be done within a period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Disposed of accordingly.
