Result of the petitioner for the post of PGT Mathematics (Rest of Haryana) has been brought in sealed cover. On opening, it is revealed that the petitioner, an applicant in the BC-A category, has secured 88 marks out of 200. The breakup of which is 74 marks in written examination, 2 marks for experience and 12 marks in viva voce. The minimum cut off in the BC-A category is 100. The petitioner does not make the mark. The result is retained on record as Mark-A.

In view of the above factual position, the instant petition is dismissed as not pressed.

However, in the event of non-joining of the candidates in the BC-A category, if the merit goes down to 88 or below, then the case of the petitioner can always be considered, if he is found eligible.
