Petitioner Sunny Kumar has filed this second petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.110 dated 15.07.2018, registered at Police Station Sector 20, District Panchkula, under Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

In the present case, the allegations are that 5 boys on two motor cycles snatched one purse containing ₹2600/- and one ATM of the complainant after showing the knife. The complainant has already been examined in this case.

The petitioner has been in custody since 15.07.2018. He is not

required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
