Grievance of the petitioner is that he has not been accorded the benefit of 'Assured Career Progression Scheme', as contemplated under instructions/circular dated 25.09.1998 further amended on 03.11.2006 (Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively). In the premise, the petitioner also submitted a representation dated 20.02.2018 (Annexure P-3), which has not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation (Annexure P-3) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
