Prayer is for setting aside order dated 30.5.2019 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge releasing the respondent No.2 on regular bail subject to furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that respondent no.2 alongwith co-accused had defrauded many investors of huge amount and respondent no.2 is one of the accused. He has submitted that there is a cheating of approximately of more than 2 crores, out of which Rs. 35 lacs belongs to the petitioner.

Case is triable by Magistrate. Investigations have been completed. Final report has been submitted in Court. Prosecution intends to examine 140 witnesses. Conclusion of trial is likely to take some time.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of by modifying the order dated 30.5.2019 only to the extent that respondent

No.2 shall furnish personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 10 lacs with surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.
