Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Rohit Narang son of Kashmiri Lal Narang in case F.I.R. No.225 dated 05.06.2019 under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 379, 427, 447, 452 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Rai, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel representing petitioner contended that petitioner is in custody since 05.06.2019 and during investigation, Section 307 IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act have already been deleted and the remaining offences are not attracted against the petitioner because he is undisputedly owner of the property and complainant-Ankit has not paid the rent for over a period of two months; the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Sub Inspector-Naresh, has affirmed the fact that Section 307 IPC and Section 25/27 of the Arms Act have been deleted.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage, but taking the above facts into consideration and the fact the petitioner is in custody since 05.06.2019; trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner—Rohit Narang, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
