The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 43 dated 09.05.2019, registered under Sections 326, 324, 323, 34 of the IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

The operative part of the order dated 03.07.2019, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that initially the FIR was registered under Section 324, 323 and 34 of the IPC, however, later on, Section 326 IPC was added with regard to an injury which is in fact attributed to co-accused Vikram Singh @ Manga. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that during the pendency of the anticipatory bail application before the Additional Sessions Judge, the petitioners were granted interim anticipatory bail and they have joined investigation, vide order dated 03.06.2019, however, the same was rejected only on the ground that the recovery of weapon was not effected from co-accused. It is further submitted that it is a case of version and cross-version.

The Investigating Officer ASI Shinda Masih, who is present in Court, submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 03.07.2019, have joined the investigation and they are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 03.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
