The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 116 dated 17.06.2019, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station City Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 03.07.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

**“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
48 bottles of country made liquor already stands
recovered from co-accused Rajvir Singh @ Raju and
nothing is left to be recovered from the petitioner.**

Notice of motion for 24.07.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 03.07.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Maninder Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any

further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 03.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
