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**MANOJ BAJAJ, J.**

Petitioner-Beera Singh has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.76 dated 04.05.2019 under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 Act registered at Police Station Sadar, Sangrur, District Sangrur.

On 04.05.2019 at about 5.00 p.m., when the Police party was on patrol duty at 'T' point kulra link road in the area of kheri, a secret information was received regarding sale of intoxicants by Lakhwinder Singh @ Kalu and Beera Singh (petitioner). Acting upon the same, both accused were apprehended. After formalities, the search was conducted and 600 and 450 intoxicating tablets of clovidol 100 SR were recovered from them respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. According to him, the further custody of the petitioner may not be justified.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State who is assisted

by ASI Sukhwinder has opposed the prayer for grant of bail on the ground that the contraband recovered from the petitioner falls within the commercial quantity. Further, he submits that investigation is pending.

Considering the above and the fact that it is a recent FIR which was registered on 04.05.2019 and investigation of the case is pending, this Court does not find any ground to extend the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed.
