Petitioner was granted parole for six weeks by this Court vide order dated 4.4.2019, passed in CWP No.30234 of 2018 titled as Ghannu vs. State of Punjab and others, in order to meet his family members.

Now, the petitioner seeks extension of parole for a period of four more weeks on the ground that his son is admitted in hospital and he is required to take care of his son. The perusal of certificate dated 26.6.2019 (Annexure P2) shows that Kanwal son of the petitioner, aged about 15 years, was admitted in Government Medical College, Amritsar on 26.6.2019 for implant removal. He is required to stay in the hospital for minimum two weeks.

I am of the view that removal of implant is not a major surgery. Wife of the petitioner is already there. Petitioner has been granted maximum parole of six weeks. Petitioner himself is otherwise all right. There is no ground to extend the parole.

Resultantly, the present petition stands dismissed.
