Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.169 dated 02.05.2019, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 03.07.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, filed by the petitioner against the complainant, is already pending before the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hisar and the present FIR is a counter-blast to the same.

Notice of motion for 14.08.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in

the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Today, A.S.I. Ram Parkash, who is present in the Court, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of order dated 03.07.2019 and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 03.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

The observations may not be considered as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
