The grievance of the petitioner is that his pay has wrongly been fixed vide impugned letter dated 24.01.2018 (Annexure P-9). He further seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise/protect his pay in terms of Rule 4.4.(b) of the Punjab Civil Services Volume-I, Part-I.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner caused issuance of a legal notice dated 05.04.2018 (Annexure P-13) through his counsel, but the same has not been adverted to till date.

4. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant

Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice dated 05.04.2018 (Annexure P-13) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
