Prayer in present writ petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents for refunding the amount of late fees to the petitioners with interest @ 9% per annum.

Notice of motion.

On asking of Court, Mr.Hitesh Pandit, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents/State.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of petitioners submits that petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent no.3 to consider and decide representation dated 22.05.2019 (Annexure P-10) within some specified time.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners and without going into merit of case or commenting thereon,

present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 to decide the representation dated 22.05.2019 (Annexure P-10) by passing a well reasoned and speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, representation is not decided within aforementioned specified time, there shall be costs of Rs.25,000/- to be paid by the concerned officer to the petitioners.
