The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.2.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 14226 of 2017. The said order is reproduced below:

“Short affidavit of Jasdeep Singh Saini, Assistant Inspector General of Police, Personnel-II, C.P.O., Punjab has been filed in court.

Learned State counsel at the outset submits that cases of the petitioners are under consideration. He has referred to para 4 of the affidavit.

In view of the fact that the issue is under consideration, no cause of action survives in this petition. Needless to observe that respondents would take a decision at the earliest as regards the entitlement of the petitioners for appointment, preferably within three months.

Disposed of.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners realising that no notice has been given after the expiry of the period after arguing for some time, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition at this stage with liberty to serve notice to the respondents.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. There is no doubt that atleast after service of notice the respondents shall consider the seriousness of the matter that direction issued by the Court was time bound..
