The petitioner has challenged the order dated 28.11.2018 whereby his application for preserving CCTV footage from 14.08.2018 to 16.08.2018 has been declined.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that he has received instructions that the CCTV footage of only last 90 days is to be preserved in the DVR of the branch. The CCTV footage of 16.08.2018 is not preserved or available with the branch. He has furnished a copy of the mail received on 11.07.2019 from the Branch Head, Axis Bank, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the respondent, this petition has been rendered infructuous.

The petition stands dismissed as infructuous.
