In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the order of termination of the services of the petitioner dated 16.05.2017 (Annexure P-6).

At the time of arguments, counsel for the petitioner states that against the order of termination of his services, petitioner has preferred an appeal dated 04.02.2019 (Annexure P-10) to the higher authorities.

Counsel for the petitioner states that though the appeal was filed on 04.02.2019, even after expiry of more than five months, no order has been passed by the respondents and the pendency of the said appeal is causing prejudice to the petitioner. Counsel further states that petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to

respondent No.1 to decide the appeal dated 04.02.2019 (Annexure P-10) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.1 is directed to decide the appeal dated 04.02.2019 (Annexure P-10) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
