Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.70 dated 15.06.2019 under Sections 61/78 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Chajjli, District Sangrur.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 05.07.2019: -

“... Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to registration of the FIR, 02 persons have already been arrested and recovery has been effected...”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Jugraj Singh, has

submitted that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
