Through this application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act prayer has been made for condonation of 18 days' delay in filing the appeal.

Heard.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed.

Delay of 18 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

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Through this appeal appellant-claimant has laid challenge to award dated 05.11.2008 passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Jhajjar (hereinafter referred to as the 'Tribunal'), whereby his claim petition under Section 163-A of the Motor Vehicles Act (for short the 'Act') was dismissed.

Heard.

Since, appellant before the Tribunal claimed his income more than ₹6,000/- per month i.e. ₹72,000/- per annum, therefore, the Tribunal has rightly dismissed his claim petition under Section 163-A of the Act

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being not maintainable.

No interference is called for in the impugned award.
