The present petition has been filed to challenge therein order dated 14.05.2019 passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Jalandhar dismissing an application filed by the petitioner seeking therein review of the order dated 08.03.2019 through which the respondents had been permitted to lead additional evidence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that since in pursuance to the order impugned in the present petition, the respondents have already led additional evidence in the form of examination of two witnesses, he does not press the present petition. However, he prays that since the petitioner's suit is pending for the last about seven years, the Trial Court be directed to finally adjudicate upon the same in a time bound manner.

In view of the above statement, the present petition is disposed of as not pressed.

In the light of the fact that the petitioner's suit is pending for the last about seven years and after cross-examination of aforesaid two witnesses produced by the respondents, the matter is only to be finally

argued, the Trial Court is directed to finally adjudicate upon the petitioner's suit within two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If the respondents are aggrieved by passing of the present order they are at liberty to approach this Court by filing of an appropriate application.
