In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is for the release of the gratuity. To claim the gratuity, the petitioner has already having a remedy under the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 (for short 'the Act').

Counsel for the petitioner states that the gratuity has been released but without interest. Even for the said relief, the provision is there under the aforesaid Act for the grant of interest and the petitioner can avail appropriate remedy before the competent Authority.

Counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition to approach the said authority by filing appropriate application.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
