Reply filed on behalf of respondent No.4 is taken on record.

Present petition is under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus.

In compliance of the order dated 25.09.2018 passed by this Court, Detenue Pardeep Singh son of Late Balihar Singh as well as respondent No.4 have been produced before this Court today and detenue-Pardeep Singh along with respondent No.4 has made the following statement:-

“I am 12 years old. My father has died. At present, I am staying with my uncle (Chacha) Shri Dharam Singh son of Sarup Singh, age 48 years, resident of Village Bhame Kaland, Tehsil Sardulgarh, District Mansa. I want to reside with my uncle, who is present in the Court out of my own free will. I do not want to go and reside with my mother/petitioner-Kulwinder Kaur, as she has remarried with Kuldeep Singh, who has got criminal record.”

In view of the above statement of Pardeep Singh along with respondent No.4, no further action is required and the present petition stands dismissed. However, the petitioner, if so advised, may approach the Guardian Court.
